The Dalhousie University, Department of Emergency Medicine is accepting abstracts for oral presentation at the East Coast Emergency Medicine Research Series. Emergency Medicine Residents, Fellows, Faculty, Nurses, Staff, and Paramedics are invited to submit abstracts for research projects relating to Emergency Medicine, Pediatric Emergency Medicine and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) no later than March 27th, 2023. There will be **NO** late entries. Abstracts not following submission instructions will be returned and required to resubmit by the deadline.

This event will take place over three (3) biweekly sessions starting on April 25th and wrapping up on May 23rd. The sessions taking place on April 25th and May 9th (2-4PM) will be virtual with the final event in this series on May 23rd (1:00 PM – 4:00 PM) taking place in person in Halifax, NS with an option to attend virtually.

Selection Process: We have developed a process for abstract selection which includes a review of all abstract submissions by a panel of reviewers. Residents and fellows: please consult with your program director to see if you are required to present in order to graduate.

NOTE: Only completed studies from faculty and staff will be considered.

Abstracts must be typed using 12-point Times New Roman font, single-spaced.
Please submit abstracts (Word format only) to melissa.macdougall@dal.ca

They must contain:

1. Introduction
2. Methods
3. Results
4. Conclusions

In addition:

- The maximum length is to be 300 words as per CAEP guidelines
- The text should be left-justified
- Abbreviations should be kept to a minimum and defined when first used.

*Please note that each presentation will be 7 minutes, plus 3 minutes for discussion.
