Corinne is an Associate Professor in UBC's Department of Emergency Medicine, Scientist at the Centre for Clinical Epidemiology and Evaluation, and an Associate Member of UBC's School of Population and Public Health. She practices Emergency Medicine at Vancouver General Hospital. Her main research interests are in emergency medicine, patient safety, health systems innovation and more recently COVID-19. In 2020, she became the Chair of the Canadian COVID-19 Emergency Department Rapid Response Network (CCEDRRN) which continues to generate evidence to inform decision-making during the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2022, was awarded the Dr, Ian Stiell Researcher of the Year Award by CAEP.
